


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# Magna Carta (1215)





- Limited Power of the King
- KEY CONCEPTS
  - Rule of Law-
    - no one is above the law
  - ➤ Guaranteed <u>due</u>

process and trial by jury

Empowered the people

### Magna Carta (cont.)



- Due Process-
  - legal procedures to ensure a person's rights are protected
  - Ensures rights and equality of all citizens

# **English Bill of Rights**

- Direct result of Glorious Revolution
- Further limited power of the king and emphasized rule of law
- Guaranteed:
  - > Free elections- 24 (kind of)
  - Elimination of cruel and unusual punishment- 8
  - Right to bear arms- 2
  - Freedom of speech-1
  - Due process- 5





#### Common Law




- Law based on <u>Precedent</u>
