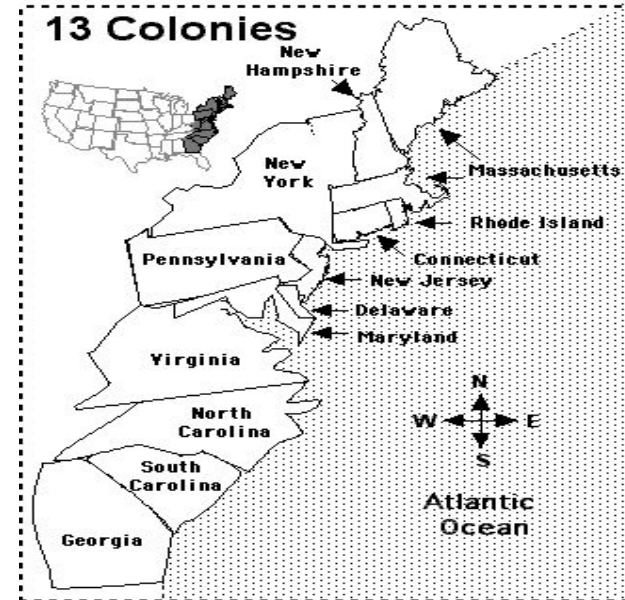

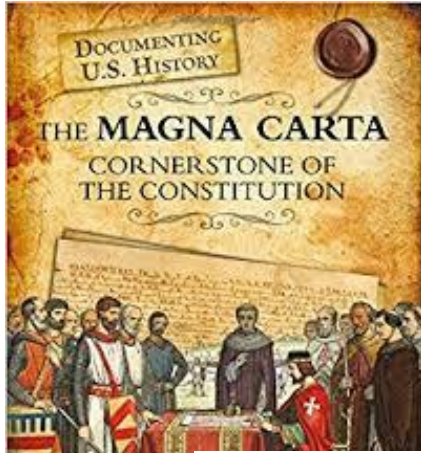

Magna Carta (1215)



- ❖ King John
- ❖ Limited Power of the King
- ❖ KEY CONCEPTS
 - Rule of Law-
 - no one is above the law
 - Guaranteed due process and trial by jury
 - *Empowered the people*

Magna Carta (cont.)



Due Process-

- legal procedures to ensure a person's rights are protected
- Ensures rights and equality of all citizens



Parliament

- ❖ Tides turn during the Glorious Revolution of 1688

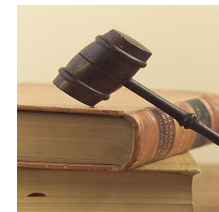


English Bill of Rights

- ❖ Direct result of Glorious Revolution
- ❖ Further limited power of the king and emphasized rule of law
- ❖ Guaranteed:
 - Free elections- 24 (kind of)
 - Elimination of cruel and unusual punishment- 8
 - Right to bear arms- 2
 - Freedom of speech- 1
 - Due process- 5

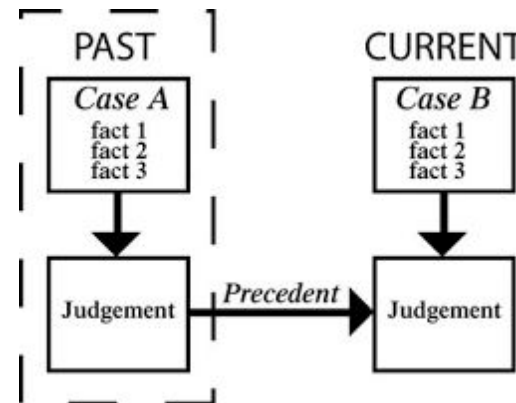
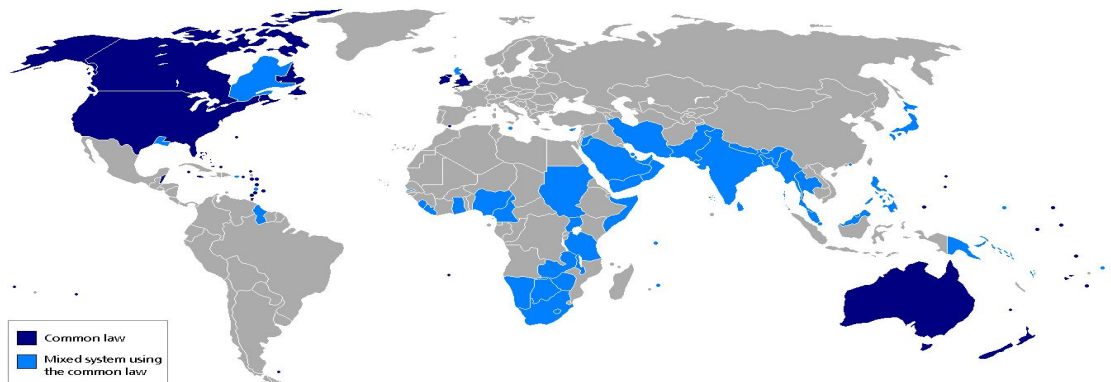


Common Law
